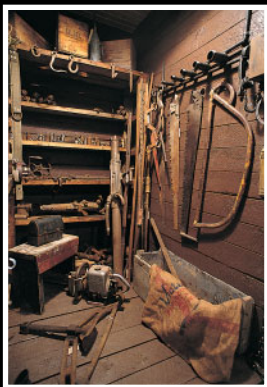
The Keno City Mining Museum is housed in an old dance hall built in the 1920's originally called "Jackson Hall".



The Museum captures the Gold & Silver mining history in the area which began in the early 1900's.
