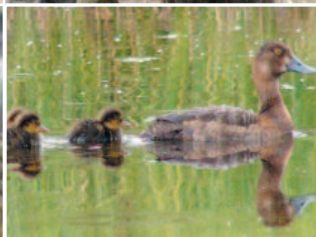
yukon wildlife preserve



The Yukon Wildlife Preserve, situated northwest of Whitehorse, is a unique wildlife viewing experience featuring northern mammals in their natural environment.

Encompassing over 700 acres, the Preserve features distinct natural habitats and offers many scenic photo opportunities.

Join our safe, 75-minute guided interpretive tour to observe and learn more about Yukon wildlife. Tours are conducted every two hours in our 24 passenger bus. Walking tours and customized visits of this education and conservation facility are possible by special arrangement.

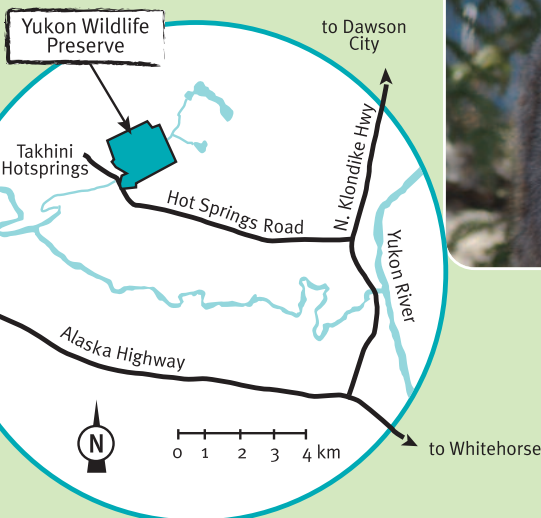
