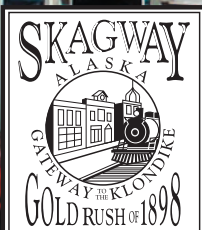


Skagway has long been known as the Gateway to the Klondike. Our gold rush past is preserved in the downtown historic District. Much of downtown is part of the Klondike Gold Rush National Historic Park. Downtown features a hundred or so businesses. We have numerous eateries, live entertainment venues, saloons, museums, two interpretive centers (including one operated by the National Park Service), RV parks, historical points of interest. Come see for yourselves and don't forget to go for a stroll along our new waterfront walkway. It's beautiful.

Skagway is the home of the White Pass & Yukon Route Railway. It's one of the few remaining narrow gauge trains operating in the world. An unforgettable ride through the coastal mountains and a unique way to view the history of the region. For more excitement try a helicopter ride to one of our local glaciers or just walk/hike to one on your own.

The Chilkoot trail is just nine road miles from town and the ghost town of Dyea is still haunted with the souls of thousands of gold rush prospectors.

Stop by the Skagway Visitor Center on Broadway. It's the building with over 9,000 pieces of driftwood on it. It's a great resource for local maps, self guided tour information and a lot more!

By Vehicle... Skagway is only 110 miles/180 km. south from the Alaska Highway via the South Klondike Highway.

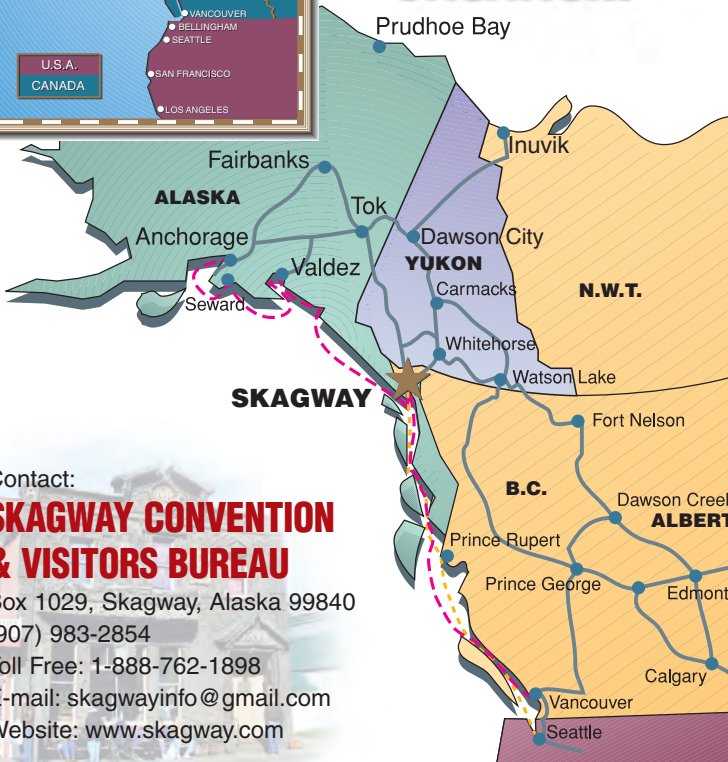
By Ferry... Skagway is the northern terminus of the Alaska Marine Highway System. A fleet of modern car carrying vessels serves Juneau, Ketchikan, Sitka, Haines and many other Southeast Alaskan communities. You can also get to Prince Rupert, BC and Bellingham, WA via this ocean highway.

By Air... A 45 minute commuter flight from Juneau, the primary domestic air entry point for Southeast Alaska and travellers on the Inside Passage.

By Cruise Ship... Almost all of the cruise lines calling on Alaska include Skagway in their itineraries.
